Composer's notes

The opening needs to be sung delicately and without rushing. Tempo indications are a guide and will depend largely on the acoustic of the building you're singing in; changes to tempo (such as rit... poco allarg... etc.) are only as long as the dotted extension shows – after this assume an 'a tempo'. There should be a build up with a sense of agitation as you reach the second half of verse three: 'And when he's killed by cruel men' which then flows into a celebration on 'your Blessed Name' before calmly returning to the opening verse to conclude the piece.

I'd like to thank Michael for permission to use his text in this composition, and I hope that he feels that I have done it justice!
